Sorrel & Sage Woodland Wisdom will also aim to: -

- Abide by all relevant environmental legislation.
- Act responsibly with regards the consumption of water and energy within their workspaces.
- Support initiatives to encourage others to act responsibly with regards the consumption of water and energy within their organisations.
- Encourage car sharing and the use of public transport as an alternative to each individual using a private car.
- Re-use or recycle materials, where possible.
- Reduce the use of non-renewable resources, where possible.
- Minimise the amount of waste generated.
- Procure and use the least environmentally damaging products.
- Bear in mind the environmental implications of any future projects undertaken by Our Organisation.

- Monitor the compliance with this policy and rectify any breaches.
- Review the policy annually to take into account changes in environmental legislation or in the activities of Sorrel & Sage Woodland Wisdom.
